Dear Deputy Director:

This is an appeal, by and through the undersigned counsel, from the action memorialized in the attached (as Exhibit A) letter of November 2, 2005, received November 3, 2005, refusing, or failing, to provide information, under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), requested by American Atheists, Inc. in the attached (as Exhibit B) letter of October 10, 2005.

My client, American Atheists, Inc., disputes the assertion that the Administrative Office does not have the records requested, and appeals from the action taken.

My client further disputes the assertion that the White House is exempt from the requested disclosure, and appeals from the action taken.

Both assertions are refuted by information available in the public press, a sample of which is reproduced below (as Exhibit C).

My client states that any privilege the White House has, or may have had, in the subject matter requested been waived by statements made by James Dobson and others disclosing, to the public at large, the general nature and content of the statements sought under the FOIA.
