This is a formal request by the organization "American Atheists, Inc.," by and through its undersigned counsel and Kentucky State Director, for any and all records, of any nature whatsoever, relevant to information provided to one James Dobson, of the organization "Focus on the Family," touching on any aspect of the qualifications of Harriet Miers for the position of Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States of America, including, but not limited to, copies of all pertinent memoranda, e-mails, phone logs, transcripts, and notes, together with any other written, printed, or electronically stored moralizations of any communiqués made by Karl Rove, and by other persons, either known to your office, or who, through the exercise of reasonable diligence, can become known. It is believed that the records sought were originated within the Office of Administration between the dates of September 10, 2005 and October 10, 2005, by Karl Rove, and by other persons, either known to your office, or who, through the exercise of reasonable inquiry, can become known.

These records are requested under the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. § 552). The exemptions of 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b) do not apply. American Atheists, Inc. states it is willing and able to pay applicable fees incurred by this request. The telephone number at which the undersigned requestor can be reached is (859)-384-7000. This request should be expedited in order to protect the rights of the requestors to petition the government for redress of grievances, together with their rights to due process of law and to the equal protection of the laws, as guaranteed them by the First, Fifth, and Fourteenth Amendments to the Constitution of the United States of America.
